

Report of the transnational meeting in Croatia

6th November – Sunday

In the afternoon, the arrival of the teams from France, Sweden and Spain took place. France was represented by the coordinator, Catherine Bourgin - English teacher, and three students. The team from Sweden was made by three teachers: the coordinator Kristina Bergdahl - English teacher, the headmistress, the music teacher, Ana Morin, and two students. The English teacher Pilar Troya represented the Spanish team.

7th November - Monday

9.30h- meeting the town representative, sightseeing and tour of the school

8th November-TUESDAY

08.30h - teachers' meeting, in the school library

We attended the teachers' meeting where we presented the report of the activities carried out in each country in September and October. I gave three leaflets to every team and the films about Romania, Bucharest, Mihail Sadoveanu Highschool to the coordinator. We also discussed about the logos and we decided the best one to be chosen until the end of the month.

Every team received a folder with a leaflet, a poster, a book note, the programme of the meeting, the hand-out of the workshop and the agenda of the project IMAGINE with all the activities which must be done until the end. The coordinator explained to us what a workshop is and how it should be organised. She also described for us the activities of the project.

09.30h- workshop II ("Let's meet in a different way")

The 20 students of the Croatian team, two Swedish students and three students from France played together during a one-hour workshop created by Ana Kisivan and conducted by three Croatian students.

10.30h- quiz about Anne Frank's Diary, Divergent and books in general, at the town library.

The students, organised in teams, responded to the questions of the quiz about the book they had to read and the movie they had to watch. The quiz was divided in two parts, the first one about Anne Frank's Diary and books in general and the second one about Divergent.

12.00h- Baking healthy pancakes in the school kitchen

The students prepared pancakes in the school kitchen and then, they presented a PowerPoint about the history of pancakes and their recipes around the world. They organised a contest and gave presents to whom could recognise the ingredients by tasting the pancakes.

14.00h- lunch at "Zebra"

We tasted the traditional dishes of Croatia like "sarma".

16.00h- workshop with the association for the children with mental difficulties

"Little Prince"

The students from the project and the children from this association made potteries.

We agreed on the homework for the next mobility and on the dates. The mobility in Sweden will take place between the 30th of January and the 3rd of February and the teams must arrive before the 29th of January and they must leave after the 4th of February. the coordinator of the Swedish team gave us a hand-out of the presentation for the meeting in Sweden, which is called "Let's focus on gender".

As homework, the students will search in the law of their country the aspects related to **domestic violence, rape, child spanking, maternity leave, wage gaps, gender discrimination at the workplace** laws. They will organise these findings in a Power Point presentation. They also have to read a book and watch a movie which will be decided by the coordinator of the Swedish team and will be sent by mail to each country.

For each module the teams have to create at least one workshop with the same theme and the teachers must train three students **who** would conduct the workshops.

09.30h- workshop with the students of the school for children with mental difficulties

13.00h- Cultural / artistic performance in the town theatre

The show started with the chorus singing the song Imagine and the speeches of the coordinator, the headmistress and of the mayor. Then we watched a dance performance, a poem in Esperanto and several songs performed by the students from Sweden.
