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Module III: Let's focus on religion

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Workshop 1: What unites us?

Date: 19 .04.2017

Duration: 60 minutes

Goal: letting students decide if religion is good or not, combating religious discrimination, helping students learn more

Outcome: students will get to know each other, choosing if religion is or is not a barrier between us

Activities:

1.The icebreaker "The bond between us":

For this icebreaker we are going to use a ball of rope and the students need to stay in a circle. The moderator will start, so that everyone will understand how to play. The moderator will choose a person from the circle and will ask that person a question and after that, she will hold a part of the rope and throw the ball of rope to that person. The chosen person has to answer sincerely and then choose another person to ask. We continue until every person of the circle gets to answer a question and then we are going to do it in reverse. The point of this icebreaker is to get to know each other better and to find interesting stuff about each other.

2. The Quiz

The main goal of this activity is to help students learn new things about religion, like 'who founded Islam?' or what meat is forbidden in Hinduism culture and recognizing the most beautiful sacred places like: Notre Dame du Paris or Hagias Sophia.

We hope that every student will leave with something new learned after this activity.

The important thing isn't a competition, the main goal is to help others learn new things about religion, not to compete with others.

3. The discussion

In the beginning we will start by telling the audience what we are going to ask them and explain what they have to do. We will then ask them the questions and discuss with them what we asked them. After they answer we will look for other students who would like to answer and start a debate.

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
